SOLUTION With the help of extensive community input, the Oconomowoc Area School District has developed a solution to our facilities problem. This plan will accommodate growth at the elementary level, replace our aging 1922 middle school, and equip our high school with essential performance and athletic space.

REFERENDUM On November 7, voters will be asked to decide on a \$49.6 million dollar package. The package includes building two new schools for grades 5-8, as well as adding an auditorium and more gym space at Oconomowoc High School.

TAX IMPACT If the referendum passes, next year's school tax on a home valued at \$250,000 is expected to increase by \$96.

LOCATION The two middle schools will be located on the corner of Valley Rd. and Hwy BB, and at the Clark Farm property on Hwy Z and Lapham St. Nature Hill will be protected, and the school agricultural program will be relocated within the district.

Referendum date November 7

This referendum opens up space for growth at every elementary school, provides quality instructional opportunities for middle school children, and gives Oconomowoc High School the gym and auditorium it has always lacked. We can all share in the benefits that these efficient, effective buildings will bring to our quality of life.
